STALL HOLDER Terms & Conditions

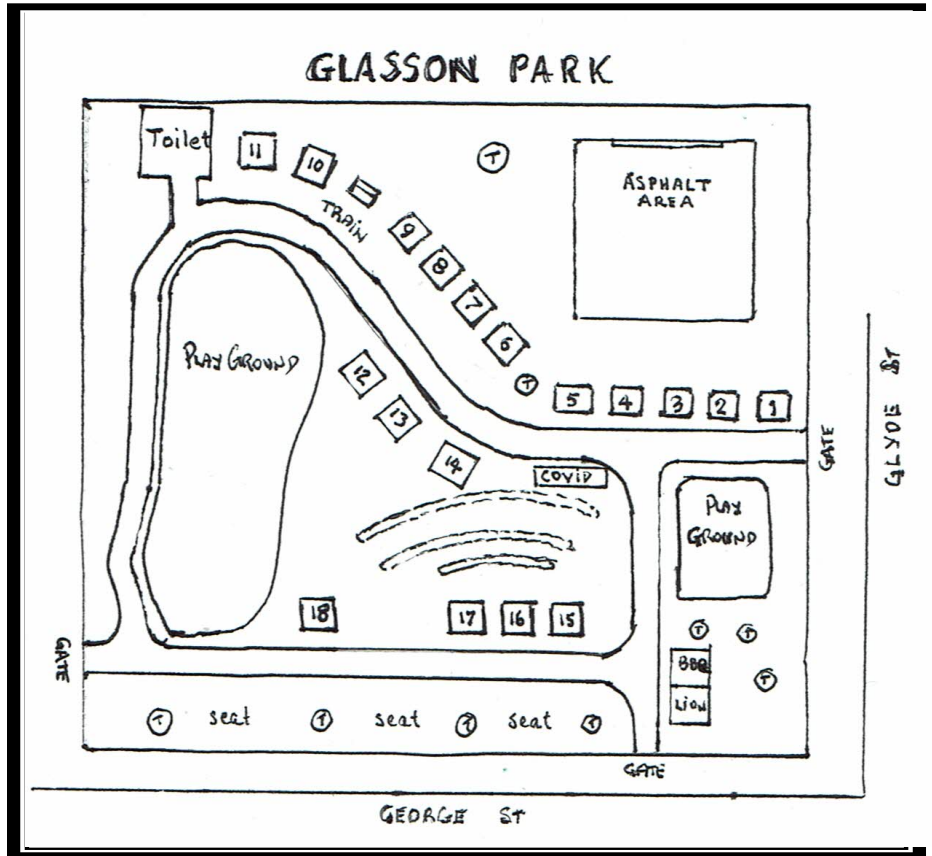
Both page 1 and 2 to be signed, with payment and copy of valid public liability insurance. Provision and updating is always the responsibility of the stallholder.

VEHICLE ACCESS: No vehicles permitted onto the park. No parking in George St (other than for setting up / pulling down). All vehicles to be moved to a distance greater than 150 metres (Tuckfeild Oval area is recommended).

START: Set-up starts at 7:00am for unloading, and vehicles are to be moved asap once unloaded.

DURING MARKETS: Stalls remain open for duration.

FINISH (12:30pm): Stalls to be pulled down, ready for loading, then vehicles may be loaded up. Area to be left clean.



- 1] Stalls will be allocated based upon signed forms AND monies being received & acknowledged. Any cancellations must be advised one week prior, or no refund may result. LIONS reserve the right to reallocate (or move) stall positions.
- 2] **CANCELLATION.** Cancellation will be by email from LIONS. If LIONS cancel the markets (bad weather or such), monies will be held over to the next market. Check with LIONS.
- 3] LIONS may reject applications (at their sole discretion).
- 4] Stallholders must utilise weights (no tent pegs/ropes) to hold down marquees (quality engineered types only, up to 3mx3m in size) on their site. There should be 4 hold down points, located at ground level, with weights of at least 18kg per point. Other infrastructure within the site (ie tables, product racks, shelves) should also be secured and not present a trip hazard. Any damage to ground by a stallholder is that stallholder's responsibility.
- 5] Power: Limited access (plse check).No electrical items (mains) to be sold. And no noise generation. Any electrical leads to be 'tagged'.
- 6] No "cooked food" or drinks are solicited.
- 7] Stallholders must fill out an "incident form" for any damage or injury (forms are at LIONS stall).
- 8] Directions from LIONS shall be respected and followed. Uncivil or unsafe behaviour will not be tolerated.
- 9] Stallholders indemnify LIONS against any loss , damage or injury arising from their participation.
- 10] No person under the age of 18 may be left in charge of a stall.
- 11] COVID-safe Management Plan. Stallholders are to ensure correct cleaning of goods and personnel for COVID protection, and to maintain a 2 square metres social distancing (until restrictions cease).
