STALL COSTS: \$35 (or as agreed).

No powered sites are offered presently (buskers may enquire). **Stalls based upon 3x3m. Speak to us (if needed).**

STALL HOLDER Terms & Conditions

Both page 1 and 2 to be signed, with payment and copy of valid public liability insurance. Any food stalls are to have current license and Town of East Fremantle approval. This is always the responsibility of the stallholder.

VEHICLE ACCESS: access is only via the park's car-park.
*** No vehicles are permitted onto the grounds.**

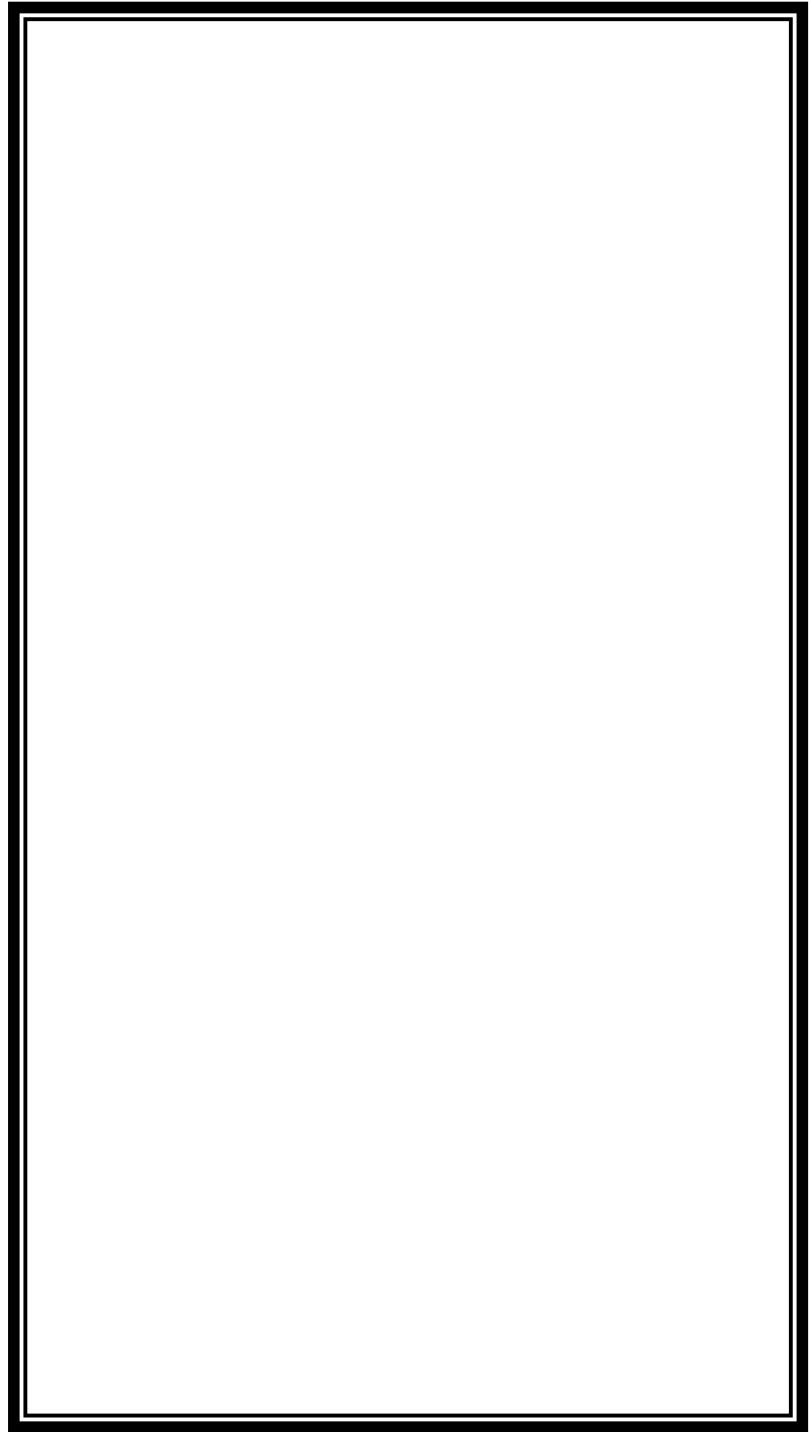
START: Set-up starts at **7:00am** for unloading, with vehicles to be moved asap once unloaded. All vehicles to be moved away (to Tonkin Park or **strictly over 100m,**) by 8:45am.

DURING MARKETS: Stalls remain open for duration.

FINISH (1:00pm): Stalls to be pulled down, ready for loading, then vehicles may be loaded up. Area to be left clean.

STALL HOLDERS INSTRUCTIONS

- 1] Stalls will be allocated prior to market, based upon signed forms AND monies being received. Any Cancellations must be emailed or phoned (no text) by one week prior, or no refund may result.
- 2] If LIONS cancel the markets (bad weather or such), preference is that monies will be held over to the next market. Check with LIONS.
- 3] LIONS may reject applications at their sole discretion.
- 4] Stallholders must utilise weights (no tent pegs/ropes) to hold down marquees (quality engineered types only, up to 3mx3m in size) on their site. There should be 4 hold down points, located at ground level, with weights of at least 18kg per point. Other infrastructure within the site (ie tables, product racks, shelves) should also be secured and not present a trip hazard. Any damage to ground by a stallholder is that stallholder's responsibility.
- 5] No electrical items (mains) to be sold. And no noise generation.
- 6] No "cooked food" or coffee stalls are solicited, other than LIONS and/or Scouts sausage sizzle . A coffee van (or such source) is on site. All foodstuffs require approval by council.
- 7] Uncivil or unsafe behaviour, will not be tolerated, and must be reported to the LIONS. Policing will result as appropriate.
- 8] Stallholders must fill out an "incident form" for any damage or injury (forms are at LIONS stall).
- 9] Directions from LIONS shall be respected and followed appropriately.
- 10] Stallholders indemnify LIONS against any loss , damage or injury arising from their participation.
- 11] No person under the age of 18 may be left in charge of a stall.
